MINUTES

The members of the recruitment board (Dr. Kruschwitz y Dra. Horster and the respective supervisor (Dra. Fernández Martínez) and co-supervisors of the two positions (Dr. Kruschwitz for ESR2 and Dr. Busch for ESR3), all of them principal investigators of the EU-CARMEN-ITN, have evaluated the candidates.

The attached table includes the ordered list of candidates. The candidates have been evaluated using three different criteria: (1) degrees (affinity of them with the project), (2) grades and (3) specific knowledge required to develop the project. These criteria have been graded with a number between 1 (worst) and 3 (best), and the results have been averaged to order the candidates.

After the evaluation, it has been decided to select the candidates:
