Brief description of organisation: We are a service provider of educational programmes and services to schools and colleges. We work with local companies both large and SME's to facilitate programmes to enable young people to be prepared for the world of work. Business volunteers are trained to come into schools to assist us with the delivery of our programmes which allows young people to have contact with industry personnel. Our programmes consist of the following; Careers fairs, Mock interviews, Enterprise workshops, skills and employability programmes, Careers information and guidance, as well as Work Experience for students. We have also established TVET vocational units with local business partners, as well as worked on companies CSR strategies to fit into their local education agenda and design programmes to fit into their own Community links objectives. Our programmes are aimed to enhance students learning experience of the world of work, increase confidence building, and gave them the opportunity to improve their employment and career prospects.
