Description of the project

Project idea:

- 1. In each partner's country there will be created the local partnership which will focus 3 sectors:
- educational organisation
- youth organisation
- higher education institution
- 2. Each partnership will select one scientific field, for example: biology, chemistry, physics.
- 3. Each partnership will create an interactive workshops in selected discipline aimed at youth.
- 4. Each partnership will organize two scientific events for youth in their own country. On this events the other partners will present their workshops.
- 5. Each partner will describe their experience of creation the partnership and workshops. It will be the basis for the creation of good example of cooperation in informal education for young people.
- 6. Created model will be presented in handbook and in Internet platform, which will be the place for further cooperation and for exchange good practices and knowlage.

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Objectives	 Creation of local partnerships (in each parner's country) for informal and interactive education for young people. Establishing international cooperation and exchange a good practices in the field of informal education for young people. Developing a common model of informal education for young people. Creating a handbook in which the developed model will be presented. Creating a international Internet platform about informal education for young people.
